After spending one year at the university's Aquaculture Research Centre, he began his career in South America, first developing small scale fish farming projects in the Amazon and then as a shrimp farm manager on the Ecuadorian coast and in Dominican Republic

His wide experience in aquaculture allows him to carry out feasibility studies and to give technical advices or training both for the industrial aquaculture and for small scale fish farming development projects.

After more than 15 years in the aquaculture production, he starts working for the European Commission at the General Directorate for Maritime Affairs and Fisheries where he gains experience in auditing governmental institutions. His auditing skills enable him to quickly obtain a global view of a fisheries or aquaculture system or industry and to detect ways of improvement. For example, he has evaluated at national level many governmental fisheries control systems but also a national system to ensure biosecurity for aquaculture. Mr Libioulle is also able to prepare aquaculture facilities for different certification schemes.
